the amendment (No. 3399) proposed by Mr. SHELBY

Viz:

1 On page 145, line 16, strike “2020.” and insert
2 “2020: *Provided further*, That of the amount appropriated
3 under this heading, not less than \$1,000,000 shall be used
4 to support and augment new and ongoing investigations
5 into the illicit trade of synthetic opioids, particularly
6 fentanyl and its analogues, originating from the People’s
7 Republic of China: *Provided further*, That not later than
8 180 days after the date of the enactment of this Act, the
9 Secretary of the Treasury, in coordination with the Ad-

1 administrator of the Drug Enforcement Administration and
2 the heads of other Federal agencies, as appropriate, shall
3 submit a comprehensive report (which shall be submitted
4 in unclassified form, but may include a classified annex)
5 summarizing efforts by actors in the People’s Republic of
6 China to subvert United States laws and to supply illicit
7 synthetic opioids to persons in the United States, includ-
8 ing up-to-date estimates of the scale of illicit synthetic
9 opioids flows from the People’s Republic of China, to the
10 Committee on Appropriations, the Committee on Home-
11 land Security, and the Committee on Financial Services
12 of the House of Representatives and the Committee on
13 Appropriations, the Committee on Homeland Security and
14 Governmental Affairs, and the Committee on Banking,
15 Housing, and Urban Affairs of the Senate.”.
