**A BILL**

To reinstate certain sanctions imposed with respect to Iran.

1       *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. REINSTATEMENT OF CERTAIN SANCTIONS IM-**  
4 **POSED WITH RESPECT TO IRAN.**

5       Any statutory sanctions imposed with respect to Iran  
6 pursuant to section 1244(c)(1) or 1247(a) of the Iran  
7 Freedom and Counter-Proliferation Act of 2012 (22  
8 U.S.C. 8803(c)(1) and 8806(a)), or section 1245(d)(1) of  
9 the National Defense Authorization Act for Fiscal Year  
10 2012 (22 U.S.C. 8513a(d)(1)), that were waived, sus-  
11 pended, reduced, or otherwise relieved pursuant to an

1 agreement between the United States and the Islamic Re-  
2 public of Iran, including any waiver that is the subject  
3 of the document entitled “Waiver of Sanctions with Re-  
4 spect to the Transfer of Funds from the Republic of Korea  
5 to Qatar” and transmitted to Congress on September 11,  
6 2023, are hereby reinstated and any action by the United  
7 States Government to facilitate the release of funds or as-  
8 sets to Iran pursuant to such agreement, or provide any  
9 further waiver, suspension, reduction, or other relief pur-  
10 suant to such agreement, is hereby prohibited.
